Declaration

I acknowledge and confirm the following:

1. The information I have provided in this form is true and correct.
2. I am an 'eligible' customer as defined in the *Electricity Industry (Licence Conditions) regulations 2005* as a residential customer, a customer that is a school, university or other educational institution, or a customer that is a not-for-profit organisation.
3. My system is or will be designed and installed by a Clean Energy Council-accredited designer and installer (please note that you may be required to provide documentation to Synergy to substantiate your response).
4. I must obtain Western Power's approval of the small renewable energy system before the system is connected to Western Power's electricity network.
5. I will comply with Western Power's technical connection requirements and ensure a Western Power approved bi-directional meter has been installed prior to the transfer of electricity from the small renewable energy system into Western Power's electricity network.
6. I authorise Synergy to verify the system installation with State and/or Federal Government agencies and entities as required.
7. I have read, understood and accept Synergy's Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme terms and conditions and agree to be bound by those terms and conditions.
8. If I am renting, occupying or leasing the premises where the system is installed, I have the owner's consent to apply for the Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme.
9. The total maximum inverter capacity of the small renewable energy system is not less than 500 watts, and not more than 5kW.
10. If I choose to expand the system capacity or inverter size of my small renewable energy system, beyond the approval provided by Western Power, then I acknowledge that I am required to submit a 'change of system' application to Synergy.
11. If I move into a property that is already a part of the existing Residential Net Feed-in Tariff Scheme and I choose to expand my inverter capacity beyond that previously approved by Synergy, I will no longer be eligible to participate in the Residential Net Feed-in Tariff Scheme.
12. A new meter or meter upgrade may be required before my small renewable energy system can be connected. The cost of this will be charged to the applicant and will be displayed on the bill (current pricing can be viewed at synergy.net.au).
13. A Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme application fee may be applicable on all new applications (current pricing can be viewed at synergy.net.au).
