

Western Australia - connection flowchart

- Customer to do own research
- Customer finds a CEC Accredited Installer
- Installer selects/designs a PV system to meet the customer's requirements
- Installer / customer submits an Application to Connect with the electricity distributor
- Electricity distributor accepts Application to Connect and sends email notification to the installer / customer with approval reference number
- Customer to contact retailer about receiving and eligibility to both the REBS and the feed-in tariff (FIT)
- Electricity retailer to check Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme (REBS) eligibility and meter compliance
- Retailer informs customer of REBS eligibility and FIT
- If new meter is needed, electricity retailer raises metering service order with Meter Provider. If meter is compliant, then the meter is reprogrammed for REBS and the system connection is recorded.
- Meter is installed
- Meter Provider invoices electricity retailer for metering services. Retailer to on-charge the customer. Customer pays charge
- Solar PV system is installed
- Installer to submit the appropriate preliminary and completion notices to the electricity distributor
- Apply for any applicable Renewable Energy Certificates / Solar Credits
- Customer is put on the Renewable Energy Tariff and a confirmation letter is sent to the customer.
